Mondag the 2nd of July - Welcome to Denmark Arrival, registration and check in of the participants in Billund. Posiblility to visit Legoland on your own. Legoland has been visited by more than 44 mio. people since the opening in 1968.	This fantastic amusement park is built around the world known Danish toy product LEGO. In the evening there will Congress at Hotel Propellen in Billund. Night accommodations at Hotel Propellen, Billund.
Tuesday the 3rd of July - Mols Bjerge (Mols Mountains) Visit at "Glasmuseet Ebeltoft" (The Glass Museum in Ebeltoft) that was established in 1985, in the more than 700 year old city of Ebeltoft. Visit at "The Frigate Jutland" that has played an important role in Danish history. From here we go to the idyllic landscape of "Mols Bjerge". In the scenic landscape in Mols Bjerge the Danish state carries out landscaping. As a part of the project to maintain the nature, herds of a local desig- ned crossbeef breed "woodcattle" are grazing the hills. The woodcattle have existed for more than 25 years. The main purpose with the herd is grazing nature areas and landscaping to prevent these areas from growing into wood. Most of Mols Bjerge is owned by the Danish state and is	appointed as nature conservation area. The aim is to preserve the scenic landscape with both woodland and open areas the fauna — all can be achieved with the grazing cattle. We will have our lunch in Mols Bjerge before we go to Højgaarden Limousin owned by Karin and Jørn Højgård Sørense Limousin. Night accommodations will be at Hotel SAS Radisson, Aarhus.
Wednesday the 4th of July - Meetings and Marselisborg Technical meeting on limousin breeding. You will be informed on the Danish breeding system including the performance testing on bull calves for beef production traits as well as the evaluation on maternal traits in the herds. Principles for handling of data and calculation of indices will also be illuminated. Finally the latest news from the other countries will be discussed. Trip for companions to "Den gamle by" (The old Village) – the museum city in the middle of big modern Aarhus where you can visit beautiful	old houses. Trip to Her Majesty Queen Margrethes summer residence "Marselisborg". Visit to "Aros", the art museum experience- house with Olafur Eliassons "Your Rainbow Panorama" on the top. Lunch in Aarhus. The evening is at your Night accommodations will be at Hotel SAS Radisson, Aarhus.
Thursday the 5th of July - The National Show in Herning Early in the morning we depart from the hotel to go to the National Show in Herning – the biggest and most distinguished show in northern Europe that open that day. More than 20 cattle breeds will enter the show. We expect a limousin exhibition with 200-250 animals. All animals will be stabled in nice surroundings. It will be possible to follow the judging and to meet the enthusiastic Danish limousin breeders. Lunch will be served in the limousin exhibition stand.	Companions who seek other experiences can join the trip to the beach at the west coast of Denmark — The North Sea. Th sand and the charming but some time harsh sea. Friday the 6th of July - National Performance Test Station We leave Herning early and go directly to the National Performance Test Station in Ålestrup. On the teststation you will receive information on the Danish performance testing on bull calves in theory and in practice. On the station, herd bulls for the future is submitted for performance testing in the age from 7-12 month regarding growth, feed efficiency, conformation, exterior and docility. All Danish Al bulls have passed the	test at the National Performance Test Station in Ålestrup. Lunch at Lynge Limousin by Lene and Per Laursen. The herd l where a big event including auction of elite breeding stock will be held. At the final Champion Show the World Congress Dinner and informal social gathering with the Danish breeders. Night accommodation at Hotel Scandic Regina, Hernin
Saturday the 7th of July - Kolding Fjord Visit and lunch at Grønbjerg Limousin by Dorthe and Kjeld Jensen. The herd has 100 cows. Visit at "Koldinghus" that is sited highly over the centre of Kolding and is thereby a dominating landmark. The castle was the last royal palace in Jutland and is today a museum that may contain the biggest collection of Danish silver besides considerable cultural and historical collections. Koldinghus was founded in the 13th century to guard	the boarder between the Danish Kingdom and the duchies of Slesvig and Holsten. Through the Middle Age Koldingh was an important part of the defence of the Kingdom. Summer party and night accommodations at the beautiful sited Hotel Kolding Fjord.
