After spending the morning at the Watsons we had a pub lunch and then moved on to join the Logan family (Homebyres herd) Humebyres, Kelso in the afternoon, this was a perfect setting to have a marvellous herd of pedigree Limousins as in the back ground to the cattle was Hume Castle they are very lucky to live in such a pretty part of the country. The Logan family are certainly doing a good job of breeding some outstanding cattle, they are using a variety of sires, Homebyres Vanhee, Arnott and Homer, Haltcliffe Eubank, Sarkley Pepsi, Anside Hawkeye, and Wilodge Fastrac these are all producing some excellent young stock, after a tour around the farm the afternoon came to a close with a lovely spread of homemade cake biscuits and tea.
