Bulls to over £5000 and Average £3308

Auctioneer Mark Bromell, Kivells, said: "It was a flying trade for well grown and well fleshed bulls. With the competition around the ring we could have easily sold double the numbers!"

The Supreme Champion and record top price of 4800gns was Loosebeare Liberal from Messrs EW Quick & Son, this June 2015 born bull is sired by Aghadolgan Emperor and is out of Loosebeare Evilla, a Rainbow Simon daughter selling to A Rowe, East Totleigh, Sheepwash, Beaworthy. Thanks to our Judge Chris Richens who said there was a very good entry of strong senior bulls, the Champion was a lovely well managed bull with a good back end. The Reserve Champion was Killerton Larch from Mr & Mrs PW & SM Greed selling to the second highest price of 4500 gns to GA Richards, Trendal Farm, Summercourt, Newquay. Again born in June 2015 Killerton Larch is by Emslies Horney and is out of Killerton Frogmore.



Killerton Lincoln sold for 3900 gns, sired by Chinauley Fibber and out of Killerton Limestone.



The Smithy herd did extremely well for Jo, Tony & Adam Smith with Smithy Leo selling for 3500gns again to GA Richards. Smithy Leo is an embryo calf by Sympa and is out of Breizisel who has previously stood as both the French and Dutch National

Champion. 2 bulls from JH Neale & Sons made 3300 and 3200 gns. Nealford Luton at 3300 gns was the first bull in the ring, sired by Glenrock Fortune and out of Nealford Gamebird, this February 2015 born sold to



AJ Eggins, Lower Uppaton Farm, Roborough, Plymouth. Selling at 3200 gns was October 2015 born Nealford Landboy, got by AI sire Ampertaine Foreman and Nealford Candy was purchased by MJ Wooldridge, Oaklands Farm, Okehampton. Top Female price of 2400 gns went to Ardlea Cucu from H & JL Parker. Selling with her September 2016 bull calf at foot, Stourhead Milo which is sired by Haltcliffe Firefly went to G S Brown, Kerswell, North Molton, Devon
