

The Master Judge for the Day was Harry Parker.

The Annual South West Limousin Summer Sale at Exeter took place on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> June. With the beginning of the shortage of grass and little rain about, the trade was selective, Michael Gollop brought a very good consignment of cows and shapely calves topping at 2570gns for “Sloughpool Eileen” a 2009 born daughter of Lumbylaw Penandpaper with her October born bull calf by Loosebeare Ipad. Also selling other similar lots at 2450gns twice, 2400gns, 2300gns, 2000gns & 1900gns. A 2009 born, in Calf Cow “Sloughpool Ellen” by Penandpaper due in July, sold for 1700gns.

Cows & calves from Messrs C & S Partridge of Tiverton saw a purebred 2014 born cow by Columbpark Firefox sell with her
